Main tasks:

Promotion of...

Innovation and Technology Innovation 2019

Main tasks:

- Support of innovation and technology incubators and accelerators in Africa
- Connecting high-quality tech hubs from Africa and Europe



Public Health

Climate Change and Sustainable Energy (CCSE) 2017

Main tasks:

- Initiation of climate actions for adaptation and mitigation of the Paris Agreement in both Africa and Europe
- Developement of renewable and efficient energy solutions

European and Developing Countries Clinical Trials Partnership (EDCTP) 2003

Public-public partnership between 16 African and 14 European countries, supported by the EU

Main tasks:

- Tackling the disparities and asymmetries in global health & health research
- Reducing the social and economic burden of povertyrelated diseases in developing countries (incl. vulnerable populations)
- Strengthening national health research capacities in Africa

CCSE Implementation: Expert Working Group

- Address the SDGs towards low-carbon and climate resilient economies
- Contribute to building resilient and sustainable energy systems to support economic growth demands in Africa and to harness the great potential of a growing youth generation
- Accompany and monitor the implementation of the measures under the CCSE roadmap by developing (i) an Action Plan, as well as (ii) a Monitoring and Evaluation framework.
- □ Formulate recommendations and suggestions to updates of the CCSE roadmap and to possible actions

CCSE Implementation: Projects (1/3)


- ☐ Total number of projects: **72**
 - **□** 49 running projects from EU calls :
 - □ 13 on climate services (10 M€) and 36 on sustainable energy
 - □ 26 from topics not requesting African participation
 - □ 23 from LEAP-RE calls

- Overall Participation
 - □ 177 (250) African organisations, 28 African countries
 - □ 425 (717) European organization, 27 European countries


Participants per African country

- Joint programme of activities with a long term perspective
 - Pillar 1: Joint call for proposals (African and European agencies)
 - First call (2021): 13 projects funded
 - Second call (2023): 10 projects funded
 - Pillar 2: 8 research actions
 - Pillar 3: Future long-term collaboration (LEAP-SE)
- 31 countries: 20 from Africa and 11 from Europe
- 83 organisations: 39 from Africa and 44 from Europe
- Total Project Cost: 32,55M€
- Total EC Funding: 14,95M€

➢ Global Framework for Climate Services (2020-2025 – 22 M€)

- > Structured interaction between users, researchers and climate services providers in Africa through User Interface Platforms (UIPs)
- Provision of climate services at continental, regional and national levels
- Improved access to climate information through strengthening observation and monitoring systems, as well as research, modelling and prediction
- > Enhanced capacity of African regions to generate and apply climate information and products relevant to their particular concerns
- Climate-informed decision-making in Africa is enhanced and climate services are mainstreamed into policy processes at regional and national levels.

> Intra-ACP Global Climate Change Alliance (2020-2025 – 9 M€)

- Enhanced capacity of AUC and ECCAS to facilitate the implementation of Africa's key flagship programmes on climate change at the regional, sub regional and national levels
- Facilitated implementation of Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs) and the Paris Agreement on climate change at regional, sub-regional and national levels
- > Stronger African voice in climate negotiations and an African Common Position
- > Enhanced resilience of communities vulnerable to climate change.
- > Strengthened national capacity to mobilise and manage climate finance
